3. REGISTRATION

Registration requirements:

- 16 years or older (born on 31 December 2008 or before).
- For Saudi nationals and residents, active SCHF athlete membership is Required.
- West Asian countries nationals must contact their national countries' federations for registration.
- If your country does not have a federation, you can register directly.
- This is a sanctioned competition; national athletes will acquire national ranking points based on their ranking in the West Asia Cup.

Teams will be provided with their accreditation during the confirmation of attendance. Team managers are requested to collect accreditation passes for their entire team and distribute them accordingly.
