#### INTRODUCTION

In years past the desert plains near Hariq were explored and sporadically developed by the local Riyadh climbing community from Riyadh. This crag, Wadi Al Akhu, which translates to 'the brother's wadi' comes from Joao Miquel who equipped the first route, the area's namesake, in April 2019.

The formal development work was undertaken by the Saudi Climbing and Hiking Federation between October 24<sup>th</sup> and November 1<sup>st</sup> 2019 during the second phase of the Saudi Bolting Project. The team consisted of the project leader and author, Read Macadam, A. Mountain Guides' Carlo Giuliberti and Piergiorgio Lotito along with Federation board member Abdulrahman Alabdu. The crag now hosts 38 climbs from 3 to 7b+.

The stone is a mix of marble and limestone and the climbing is short and technical on uniquely sculpted edges and pockets. Tons of loose stone was dropped from the cliff to bring the climbing to fruition and the talus base prepared with care, however the nature of the climbing remains dusty and wild. Wadi Al Akhu is not considered a 'child-friendly' zone. Exercise caution. Wearing a helmet is strongly encouraged.


Wadi Al Akhu Crag is a desert crag at 1,000m and, since it is generally north-facing, shade can be found all day, with only a few of the right-most sections taking sun briefly in the mid-afternoon.

#### Material:

Raumer Superstar 10mm x 100mm 316L stainless steel glue-in bolts with Hilti RE500 V3 epoxy. All of the lower-offs are Raumer Superstar 10mm x 100mm 316L combo chains with stainless steel rings.





#### From Riyadh:

Leave Riyadh on Route 80 (Makkah Road) heading west and exit southbound onto Route 30 at GPS#1. Follow Route 30 for 38km then exit left/east at GPS#2 onto road 4883 which becomes road 5397. After 29km turn right/south at GPS#3 onto road 5913. After 68km exit left at GPS#4. After 10km the paved road ends. Turn left/north before the row of trees and after approx. 1km the track curves back right/east to circumnavigate the farm to the north. Follow this track for 22km to GPS#5, turning right to pass the east side of the shepherd's trailer leading to the open gravel plain and the parking GPS.

#### From Harig:

Head west on the dual carriageway towards road 5874. Turn right/north at GPS A. After 17km exit left before the bridge at GPS B onto the gravel road. After 13.1km turn left onto the track at GPS#5, skirting the shepherd's trailer and onto the gravel plain towards the parking GPS.

4x4 high clearance vehicle required

#### Approach:


From the parking descend straight ahead into the wadi and trend right, following the cairns. The crag is at the head of the right-most wadi of the three visible from the parking. Approach time approximately 12 minutes.




#### RULES OF THE CRAG

- Never ever litter. Carry out more than you brought in
- Stay on the beaten trails. Do not cut trees
- Never modify the rock. Brush excess chalk and tick marks
- Always partner check and tie a knot in the end of your rope
- Respect the local culture, residents, animals, property and other climbers
- Dispose of human waste and paper appropriately. Leave no trace
- Use your own gear for top-roping, the last climber descends on the fixed gear






# CYADI ALAKHU SECTOR MAP


#### Al Akhu and Al Akhu


Joao Miquel and Naif at the latter's local hangout during one of Joao's trips to Hariq. Joao named his route after Naif who reminds us that we are all akhu.






The Twins is the freestanding boulder in the middle of the entire crag and named after two of Saudi Arabia's budding climbers.




Obelisk offers some of the most enjoyable climbing in Wadi Al Akhu on very compact and sculpted stone.






Slab sector has the highest concentration of easy low angle climbs making it a good warm up and school for new climbers.
